


INSPIRING THE FUTURE THROUGH STEAM

THE SPARK BEHIND EVERY SCHOLARSHIP

The GOE Scholarship Program offers a range of opportunities for students to explore aviation, space, and leadership Scholarships development. awarded for camps at the National Flight Academy in Pensacola, Florida; the U.S. Space and Rocket Center Space Camp in Huntsville, Alabama; and the Red Tail Flight Academy in Tuskegee, Alabama. Collectively, these scholarships cover camp registration, lodging, and meals, providing students with full access to immersive aviation and aerospace experiences throughout Florida and Alabama.

These scholarships build on schoolyear interactions through the Maxwell AFB STARBASE program, with which GOEF partners, to inspire children from within the community in daily classroom settings. The GOEF board has established the AY26 goal to raise \$25,000 to be awarded for Spring scholarships. Early success was evident from the first fundraiser, where students attending Air Command and Staff College contributed \$1,459. There is still much work to be done in reaching targeted scholarships. We invite you to join us in sparking interest in STEAM-related careers through sponsorship, donations, and advocacy.
